Governance Review

We have now completed the first part of the RDA Governance Review, with focus groups and interviews conducted by <u>CCE</u> (<u>Centre for Charity Effectiveness</u>). Thank you to everyone who has given their time to attend and contribute to the initial phases. CCE, who are helping us with the review, are incredibly grateful to you all for sharing your experiences and your thoughts for the future of RDA. We are also grateful to those of you who contacted the review by email, your comments have been shared with CCE.

As part of the ongoing commitment of everyone at National Office and the RDA UK Board of Trustees to engage with every RDA group, the next stage of the Governance Review is a series of roadshow events. These events, called "Our Governance – how we work together," will be held in late September and October. They are open to up to 100 attendees at each venue, and in addition there will be two online events with space for large numbers. The events will take place in the early evenings and one of the virtual events will be at the weekend. Our new CEO Michael Bishop, together with some members of the RDA UK team and RDA UK Board will be at the events.

Please look out for the event email with further details which should be with you soon. Please circulate the details widely within your RDA Group. We hope to hear from and gather the views of participants, volunteers, group trustees and coaches - everyone who is part of RDA – at these roadshows.

You told us that the MY RDA website is hard to use and delivers a poor experience. We listened to your feedback and have been building a new user-friendly website to improve the online service available. Over recent months we have been working with our digital agency partner, and an RDA volunteer testing panel, to develop the structure, functionality and look of the new site.

The project is progressing well. Over the summer our volunteer panel will be putting the new site through its paces to help iron out any bugs, ahead of an official launch at the end of September.

Please look out for further updates as we will be hosting demos and drop-in clinics ahead of the launch, and in the period immediately after, to introduce the new site and provide guidance on how to access and use it.

Equines play an essential role in delivering RDA's life changing impact for disabled people and the welfare and wellbeing of our horses is paramount to our participants, volunteers and all of us at RDA.

We hold a clear <u>position on equine welfare</u>. As responsible members of the equestrian community, alongside <u>British Equestrian</u>, fellow member bodies and associated industry leaders, RDA has pledged to the <u>Charter for the Horse</u> – a unified approach for the ethical and fair treatment of all horses under our care. Our <u>equine</u> guidance and <u>policies</u> are all available on My RDA.

The intention is this new document will answer all questions that have been asked over the past months capturing all necessary links to documents that require completion. This document will be updated monthly to ensure an accurate and complete central resource for groups to use.

Scammers are getting ever more sophisticated in their techniques and harder to spot, with an RDA Group recently being targeted by a spam caller, please be aware of this as other RDA groups may be targeted. **Don't forget, however convincing it may sound, your bank will never contact you direct and ask for banking details over the phone.**

Now is a suitable time to brush up on your knowledge and check your security processes. The National Cyber Security Centre, Charity Digital, Take Five and your own bank all offer extensive guidance and resources including:

- Phishing and what to do about it
- How to spot and report scam emails, texts, websites, and calls
- An <u>accessible toolkit</u> on how to protect yourself from scams, including an easy read guide and a screen reader version.
