CARRIAGE DRIVING PRACTICAL

- Wear approved hard hat - gloves are recommended.
- Demonstrate a safe, correct seat in the carriage, as far as ability allows.
- Demonstrate a safe mounting procedure to suit the individual.
- Hold the reins as ability allows, with adaptations as needed.
- Demonstrate beginning of control i.e. start, steer and stop, using reins and voice aids.
- Demonstrate walk on, turn right, then left and halt.

HORSE CARE AND CARRIAGE DRIVING THEORY

- Identify these parts of a horse/pony: EYES, EARS, MOUTH, NECK, LEG.
- Identify these parts of a harness: COLLAR, SADDLE/PAD AND GIRTH, BREECHING, REINS, BRIDLE.
- Demonstrate, or explain, how to approach a horse/pony correctly and safely.
- Explain what a horse/pony eats.
- Explain what a horse/pony drinks.
- Explain where a horse/pony lives.
