CARRIAGE DRIVING

arriage Driving has been an important part of RDA since 1975 and there are now over 60 groups throughout the UK, giving driving opportunities to over 1000 drivers. It is also enjoyed by people who can no longer ride due to disability, or who prefer a different kind of equine challenge.

Each group has specialised vehicles which take both ambulant and non-ambulant drivers. Wheelchairs and adaptions to the harness cater for the needs of all.

We are very lucky to have volunteers helping at Carriage Driving Groups to ensure that each driver enjoys their chosen aspect of our sport.

Drivers are accompanied by a knowledgeable and competent Carriage Driving Coach who has a second set of reins to assist if required. The groups drive in both indoor and outdoor arenas, on tracks, in woods and on the road depending on their venue and their facilities. All are different! Drivers enjoy working for their proficiency tests, practicing dressage movements and tests. driving through cones or natural obstacles such as groups of trees, and competing at both local shows and the National Championships.

At this year's Virtual Championships, we are offering three classes for Novice, Intermediate and Open competitors who will just drive a dressage test. Normally competitors would be asked to do a cones course followed by 2 or 4 obstacles.

The objective of the driven dressage test is to judge the freedom, regularity of paces, harmony, impulsion, suppleness, lightness, ease of movement and correct bending of the horses on the move. Drivers will also be judged on style, accuracy and general control of their horses, and on their dress, condition of their harness and carriage and the presentation

ressage offers the opportunity for riders to show a judge, parents, friends and helpers what has been achieved during RDA sessions. It can also help a coach to set goals, allowing the riders to demonstrate often hidden reservoirs of determination to achieve and can vividly show the benefits of previous instruction.

Dressage plays a huge part of the Virtual National Championships with a variety of classes on offer this year both Championships Classes and Freestyle Classes. We have also included this year a class that can have a leader and a side walker. They ride a specific test with a predetermined pattern in a 20m x 40m arena. A judge marks the test, they give marks out of ten for each movement set out in the test, at the end of the test the marks are added up and the winner is the combination with the highest score.

Dependent on their impairment and/or experience, participants can ride tests in walk only, walk and trot or walk, trot and canter. Dressage is a multi-disability activity but at the Virtual National Championships, intellectual disability and visually impaired riders can choose to ride in their own classes.

MUSICAL RIDE &

he Musical Ride and Carriage Drive Classes have been running for a number of years and are a great way for groups to get involved within the Virtual Championships and for riders to perform as a team.

There are two ridden classes on offer and one driven. Each entry should present a drill ride or carriage drive with riders and helpers smartly dressed using modest fancy dress if they wish, to reflect the drill ride they are demonstrating.

Music has been shown to be a powerful element to improve and energise the performance of both horse and rider or carriage driver and each year the judges look forward to seeing a wider use of music and movements to do just that.



SHOWJUMPING 🔭

DA Showjumping has its own unique Pathway giving participants valuable opportunities to take part in RDA Competitions and RDA Showjumping Proficiency Tests. The pathway entails of 5 levels, beginning at poles on the ground through to an 80cm course, catering for all.

Showjumping has proved to be a popular discipline within RDA and now has over 140 Groups taking part in level 2 or above and all groups are now able to take part in level 1, it is set to soar in the coming years.

We will be showcasing levels 1, 2, 3 and 4 at the Virtual National Championships this year.

howing is really starting to take off within RDA although it is still a relatively new discipline.

Showing teaches you how to put in a performance and accept the judges' comments as a positive way to improve. It is also a great start for a horse's education, as it teaches manners and gives exposure to the show environment without the exacting pressure of a dressage test or showjumping round.

The competition is open to all RDA riders who can walk and trot.

Classes will be judged on turnout: cleanliness and condition of equine and tack, suitability of equine for the rider and job and overall impression.

The show should comprise of a short video of the whole horse stood still including legs and body. The rider should then move onto an individual display; to include; walk, trot and canter if applicable and change of rein.

Riders should be neatly turned out, clean and tidy but tack and saddlery suitable for the rider not the show ring will be encouraged.

Teams are made up of 6 vaulters who work with one horse under the control of a lunger or a barrel. Pairs classes will run with no age restriction in walk and trot and can take place on a horse or barrel. Individuals can ride either on the barrel or horse and will be split into 3 age groups: Junior, Senior and Open.

Vaulting has significant therapeutic benefits; you can work as a team to achieve a goal which can have a huge impact on self-confidence. Vaulting also has significant physical benefits it is a great discipline for improving balance, stability motor skills, flexibility and coordination.
