REGIONAL VET



The Role:

The Regional Vet will be a port of call for any RDA Equine enquiries within their region. They will be a source of information at regional training days or regional qualifiers. This is a voluntary role is to supplement not replace the usual vet for a group.

Responsibilities:

- To support groups when needed to ensure RDA equines are suitable, effectively used to benefit RDA participants and that their welfare is paramount
- To liaise closely with Regional Coaches, County Coaches, Regional Equine Advisors and Training Advisors, in matters relating to equines.
- To contribute to the development of specific support for groups in relation to equine issues.
- To contribute to the development and evaluation of strategies and policies to support the quality and welfare of RDA equines.
- Support their region with regional and supra regional training days.
- Be available for Regional Qualifiers to check passports.

Method of Appointment:

- Appointed by the regional committee with the information forwarded onto the Equine Coordinator at the RDA National Office.
- The Vet must be actively involved in practice and up to date with the currently legislation.
