#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS**

The show is run in accordance with SHB(GB) 2025 Rules with the exception of Horse of the Year Show classes, which are run under Horse of the Year Show rules. In all HOYS classes, Horse of the Year Show rules take precedence, a copy of which can be downloaded from <u>www.hoys.co.uk</u>. Horses must be registered with either SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Members of either SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms.** Classes 2 & 3, 38, 42, 46, 51-54 are qualifiers for **Horse of the Year Show**, NEC, Birmingham, 8<sup>th</sup> – 12th October 2025. These classes entitle eligible amateur combinations to earn points for the Premier Amateur League, with the opportunity of gaining a wild card place at HOYS 2025. This is open to current TSR members or those that have signed up to the Premier Amateur League 2025, for more information see <u>www.theshowingregister.co.uk</u>. In classes 38, 46, & 51–54 no horse lower than fifth will qualify. In the Championship of classes 2 & 3, no horse lower than third will qualify. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

Horses competing at the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in The Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. Entries in these classes may not compete in the Small Show Hunter of the Year and vice versa.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.

#### **MEMBERSHIP:**

Owners and riders of horses in all ridden classes <u>must</u> be full members of SHB(GB), unless competing on a day ticket with the exception of the Ridden Irish Draught Classes, Ridden Mare & Veteran classes, Ridden Cleveland Bay classes, Burghley Young Event Horse, Sport Horse Classes and Horse of the Year Show classes. Exhibitors in In-Hand classes do not have to be members.

#### Acknowledgement of Entries and Allocation of Numbers:

#### SHB(GB) Hunter Champion Show:

Numbers will be available for collection from the Secretary's Office at the show between 2pm & 5pm on Monday 11th August; between 7am & 5pm on Tuesday 12th August and between 7am & 1pm on Wednesday 13th August.

#### **Burghley Young Event Horse:**

Start times will be available on Eventing Scores (<u>www.eventingscores.co.uk</u>) after 10:00am on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> August. Competitors to provide their own numbers/number bib.

#### SEIB R2R:

Numbers will be available for collection from the Secretary on the day of competition.

#### THERE WILL NOT BE AN EXHIBITORS' MAILOUT PRIOR TO THE SHOW.

#### SAFETY / INSURANCE:

The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

#### **OBJECTIONS:**

Objections of any kind must be made in writing, and delivered to the Secretary, within one hour of the close of the judging of the class concerned, accompanied by a deposit of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds, which deposit will be forfeited if the objection should prove to be frivolous. The Objector must also state the particular and precise character of his objection. All objections will be referred to the Council, whose decision will be final.

#### **JMB HEIGHT CERTIFICATION:**

Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL NOT be required to be in possession of a JMB Height Certificate or verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers. However qualifying animals will need to be measured WITHIN 28 DAYS OF QUALIFICATION OR BEFORE THE FINAL, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. The valid JMB full height certificate or a valid JMB annual height certificate must be submitted to the SHB(GB) office on receipt from the JMB and prior to competing at RIHS or HOYS. There are NO exceptions to this rule.

#### PRIZES:

In unsponsored ridden classes, prize money may be reduced on the following sliding scale: 3 entries - money to 1st Place only; 5 entries - money to 2nd Place only; 6 entries - money to 3rd Place only; 9 entries - money to 4th Place.

#### **BROOD MARE PREMIUMS:**

Brood Mare Premiums will be awarded in classes 9, 11, 13, 24, 35, 76, 81 & 83. Premiums will only be awarded if there are a minimum of three mares forward. The premium takes the form of a rosette and Service Voucher to the value of £100, awarded at the Judge's discretion to their selection from the monetary prize winners, to be used in either of the two years following the year of that award. The owner must be, or become, a fully paid-up member of the SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award. No mare shall take more than one award per year.

#### **PROGENY OF GRADED MARES:**

In classes 10, 12, 14-23, 25, 64, 77-80, 82, 84-90 incl. A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed exhibit out of a SHB(GB) graded mare.

#### **CLASSES:**

The Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.

Every effort will be made for classes not to clash, but once a class has started a horse cannot leave the ring to compete in another class and then return to the original class.

All entries, except foals, must be in possession of current Influenza Vaccination Certificate and such document, which must undeniably relate to the horse in question, must accompany the animal when brought to the Show and may be examined.

All entries must be on the Society's Identity Record or Stud Book before the entry is accepted unless competing on a day ticket or in a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier or in a class where it is specified that registration is not required - see conditions as printed on day ticket application form which is available to download from www.sporthorsegb.co.uk.

Entries in the Ridden Sport Horse classes, In Hand Irish Draught classes, Ridden Irish Draught classes, Ridden Mare class, In Hand Cleveland Bay classes & Ridden Cleveland Bay classes do not have to be registered with SHB(GB) and exhibitors do not have to be members of SHB(GB), but if competing in any other classes at the show a Day Ticket must be purchased. Foals at foot do not have to be registered in their own right. Exhibits in In-Hand classes do not have to be registered or over-stamped.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

All horses eligible for Championships must be forward.

#### **FIRST AID**

A first aid fee of £6 per rider or In-Hand exhibitor is payable at time of entry.

#### **General Data Protection Regulation**

Please note that there will be a photographer on site and photographs taken may be used on the SHB(GB) website, Facebook page and may be issued to Third Party Publications for the purpose of publicising the show, results and general PR in relation to SHB(GB). In addition, class sponsors may receive pictures of awards to prize winners. If you do not want any pictures that may be taken of you/your horse utilised in this way, please make the Secretary's office at the show aware.

#### Sport Horse Breeding (GB) Equine Influenza Vaccinations Policy

Any horse receiving a new Primary Course of equine influenza vaccine as of 1 January 2025 must be vaccinated as follows: 1st vaccination -2nd vaccination interval 21-60 days. Horses having received first two vaccinations may compete, providing 2nd vaccination has not been given within 7 days of arriving at an event. 3rd vaccination to be given within 6 months and 21 days after 2nd., so long as 3rd vaccination has not been given within 7 days to allow horses to compete. The minimum standard is Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements for the Primary Course, First Booster and all subsequent boosters. There is no requirement for horses that have received their primary course and first booster before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025, to be re-vaccinated provided that they have been vaccinated in compliance with the 2024 Veterinary Regulations. Horses that received their primary course before 2005 are exempt from the first booster requirement. Subsequent boosters must have been given at intervals no later than 1 calendar year after the primary course. All competitors are strongly advised to check the FEI website for ongoing FEI updates during 2025 and before 2026. it is recommended that all competitors/exhibitors/members/producers check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering, e.g. Windsor, Hickstead, HOYS, etc.

This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Sport Horse Breeding (GB) website. The current FEI ruling is for a six-monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore, it is recommended that all competitors/exhibitors/members/producers check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering, e.g. Windsor, Hickstead, HOYS etc.

NOTE: THE ABOVE WILL BE ENFORCED AT THE 2025 NATIONAL HUNTER SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW AND THE SOCIETY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CARRY OUT PASSPORT/VACCINATION RECORD CHECKS. ANY UNVACCINATED HORSES TOGETHER WITH ANY ANIMALS THEY ARE IN TRANSIT WITH WILL BE TURNED AWAY FROM THE SHOWGROUND

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR IRISH DRAUGHT CLASSES:

This show is affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and as such all exhibits entering into classes 47, 48, 63, & 64 must be eligible under the below criteria.

All owners of Pure-Bred and IDSH/Part-Bred Irish Draught horses must be Full Members of the IDHS (GB).

All Pure-Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-Hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.

All yearling, two-and three-year-old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three-year-old colts must be un-inspected.

All Irish Draught Sport Horse Breeding and Youngstock In-Hand exhibits must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. All yearling, two-and-three-year-old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three-year-old colts must be un-inspected.

**ALL RIDDEN** Pure Bred Irish Draughts must be registered with or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

**ALL RIDDEN** Irish Draught Sport Horses and part-bred must be in the correct ownership, have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

**ALL RIDERS** of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and stallions must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails

**STALLIONS** (In-Hand or Ridden) must also be inspected and over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB).

**OWNERS** Owner of Pure-Bred Irish Draught horses and IDSH (ID Part-Bred) horses must be full members of the Irish Draught Horse Society of Great Britain.

#### ALAN MARNIE & FAMILY (META LOUNGE LIMITED AND SHB (GB)) HOYS WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

All owners, riders & producers to be members of SHB, BSHA or TSR Horses must be registered with SHB, BSHA or TSR. Small Hunters to be included in Class 2. Middleweights to be included in Class 3. Failure to jump in the correct section will result in elimination. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as of 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Fences will not exceed 1.14m (3ft 9ins) in height; there should be a minimum of 8 fences and a maximum of 12 fences. The Course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray. These classes will be judged in two parts.

Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jump-off. All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation if so required (no change of rider is allowed). For classes 2 and 3 marks will be awarded in the following way:

PHASE I (60 MARKS)

A: JUMPING POINTS - 40 MARKS

B: STYLE WHILE JUMPING - 20 MARKS

PHASE II (40 MARKS)

C: CONFORMATION - 20 MARKS D: RIDE - 20 MARKS

In the event of equality, the CONFORMATION MARK from Phase II will take precedence, followed by the RIDE MARK, and then the STYLE MARK.

Both classes will be jumped over the same course and height. The highest placed unqualified horse within the top 3 of each classes 2 & 3 will qualify for Horse of the Year Show.
