

ROLE PROFILE REGIONAL SHOWJUMPING REPRESENTATIVE



The Role:

The Regional Showjumping Representative is involved in the development and promotion of showjumping within the region and works closely with the Regional and County Coaches to achieve this.

The Regional Showjumping Representative plays a vital role in working with groups to support the delivery of high quality sessions, as well as offering advice to participants and volunteers interested in the discipline or wanting to know more about the routes to competition.

All representatives have the opportunity to contribute to the development of RDA Showjumping at a national level, through participation in an annual meeting with the Showjumping Committee.

Responsibilities:

- Ensuring that groups are fully briefed on RDA UK guidelines, policies and procedures with reference to showjumping
- Visiting groups to provide ongoing advice and support, and to promote safe practices involving showjumping, including equine welfare and suitability
- Co-ordinating the organisation of regional events related to showjumping, such as showjumping qualifiers, regional training days/courses and showjumping proficiency tests
- Signposting participants looking for showjumping opportunities to suitable groups within the region
- Representing the showjumping groups on the regional committee at meetings, and informing the Regional Chairman of group events and projects within the region
- Working with the Showjumping Co-ordinator at RDA National Office to ensure that all current standards and guidelines are being adhered to in the region

Method of Appointment:

- All applicants must have completed and passed a showjumping assessment day
- A letter of recommendation from the Regional Chairman, along with an application form, is sent to the Showjumping Lead
- After consultation with the relevant Regional Chairman, the Showjumping Representative will be appointed by the Showjumping Lead.
