The first accredited safeguarding course attended must be the tutor led, face-to-face 'Safeguarding for Equestrians' course, either in venue or on Zoom. This must be refreshed three years later, and can be achieved by completing the safeguarding e-learning module. However, as a minimum, Coaches should attend a face-to-face, tutor led course (in venue or via Zoom) every six years.

The e-learning individual learning and the F2F/Zoom 'Safeguarding for Equestrians' tutor-led sessions are **not** equivalent, accredited training. Hence why Coaches should attend a face-to-face, tutor led course (in venue or via Zoom) every six years.

Scotland only

Those working in Scotland are required to complete pre-online training, called SportScotland Module 1, before attending the 'Safeguarding for Equestrians' course. This is coordinated by RDA National Office and should be completed by learners at least 7 days before the course date.
