

GRADE 1 PROFICIENCY TEST (BLUE)



VAULTING:

- Stand in line to get on the horse
- 2. Run to the horse in walk
- 3. Get away from the horse in walk
- 4. Run to the horse in trot
- 5. Get away from the horse in trot
- 6. Sit in basic seat hands on waist in walk
- 7. Bench in walk
- 8. Free kneel in walk
- 9. Leg over to inside in walk
- 10. Leg over to outside in walk
- 11. Simple dismount at walk
- 12. Thank the horse

HORSE CARE:

- 1. Identify the following points of the pony/horse: EYES, EARS, MOUTH, NECK, MANE, TAIL, HOOF AND LEG
- 2. Identify the following parts of the Vaulting tack: LUNGE REIN, BIT, WHIP, ROLLER, GIRTH, HANDLES AND BACK PAD.
- 3. Know how to approach a pony/horse correctly



Vaulting 50%, Horse Care 50%.

Examinations by RDA approved examiner not working with the Group.

Candidates may take either Vaulting and/or Horse Care and will receive a RDA certificate and badge for each section passed.
