

GRADE 2 PROFICIENCY TEST (RED)





VAULTING:

- 1. Run in as a team and bow to the judge
- 2. Run to the horse in trot
- 3. Get away from the horse in trot
- 4. Run to the horse in canter
- 5. Get away from the horse in canter
- 6. Sit in basic seat arms out (like an aeroplane) in walk
- 7. Free kneel in walk
- 8. Sit forwards on neck in walk
- 9. Mill in walk
- 10. Backward Tailor Seat in walk
- 11. Backward Tea Pot in walk
- 12. Dismount at walk
- 13. Thank the horse

HORSE CARE:

- 1. Identify the following points of the pony/horse. Those in Grade 1 plus: WITHERS, SHOULDERS, FORELOCK, KNEE, HOCK and BACK
- 2. Identify the following parts of the roller and bridle. Those in Grade 1 plus: SIDE REINS, ROLLER PAD, BRUSHING BOOTS, STIRRUPS, CHEEKPIECE AND HEADPIECE.

- 3. Recognise the following colours of pony/horse: BAY, CHESTNUT, GREY, PIEBALD, AND SKEWBALD
- 4. Know the basic markings found on a horse or pony: BLAZE, SNIP, STAR, and SOCK, STRIPE AND STOCKING.
- 5. Name the following items of the grooming kit: DANDY BRUSH, BODY BRUSH, METAL CURRY COMB, PLASTIC CURRY COMB AND HOOF PICK

PASS MARKS:

Vaulting 50% Horse Care 50%.

Examinations by RDA approved examiner not working with the Group.

Candidates may take either Vaulting and/or Horse Care and will receive a RDA certificate and badge for each section passed.
